

MS/M.Phil. Admission Test Marks Distribution

The MS Computing Programs Entry Test will assess candidates across two major portions. The test will give 50% weightage to general portion and 50% weightage to core computing areas.

1. General Portion— 50%

The general portion 50% of the test will assess candidates' reasoning and analytical abilities through:

1. English (10%)
2. Mathematics (15%)
3. Analytical Reasoning (25%)

2. Core Computing Areas — 50%

The core computing component will cover the following areas:

1. Computer Networks
2. Programming Fundamentals (C++, Java, and Python)
3. Data Structures and Algorithms
4. Operating Systems
5. Cyber Security
